Dr. Jason (Jaesuk) YUN has joined ASML Korea as a Country Privacy Officer and Privacy Business Partner for Asia in July 2021. Before joining ASML, he had worked for Korea Internet & Security Agency (KISA) over 21 years as an cybersecurity and privacy policy specialist.

He has been a vice-rapporteur of ITU-D SG2 Q3/2 (cybersecurity) since September 2014 and one of active members of ITU-D SG2 Q3/2 by submitting a number of contribution reports. He has extensive training/experience in the areas of computer network technologies, ICT & cybersecurity policy, and privacy protection and been in charge of various tasks including analysis of information security policies of OECD, APEC, ITU. He had conducted and participated a number of Knowledge Sharing Program (KSP) and Official Development Assistance (ODA) projects for developing countries. He was an ICT National Coordination Point (NCP) officer at KIC-Europe in Brussels, a research institute established by the Ministry of Science and ICT of Korea to facilitate ICT cooperation between Korea and EU in 2014.

He had been also in charge of international cooperation for personal data protection with number of stakeholders including European Commission for adequacy finding and APEC for Cross-Border Privacy Rules system (CBPRs).
