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1. INICTEL-UNI's experience in Digital Inclusion

Digital inclusion activities during the last three decades:

- Rural inhabitants To include isolated populations. Only 21.1% (INEI, 2021) of households in rural areas have Internet, so their access to information is very limited.
- Handicap people To include the 3 209,261 people (INEI, 2019) with disabilities, with limited access to technology.
- Older adults To include older adults growing group which needs digital abilities, as by 2100 people will live 82 years.
- Girls and women To include girls and women by promoting to use digital resources as their counterparts boys and men. Inequality is reported by INEI in 2021.


