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Mr. Bhatia is the President and CEO of the ITU-APT Foundation of India and Vice Chairman and head of Asia Pacific Region for Wireless World Research Forum. He also chairs the Working Group on 6G in ITU WP5D and chairs multiple groups in the APT. He is a globally recognized telecom leader with over 50 years of expertise in spectrum management and ICT policy. He was a driving force behind India's telecom liberalization, facilitating India's first mobile cellular services and was the driver for the India's first ever National Frequency Plans in DOT. He also led the international spectrum team of Motorola and pioneered the concept of Public Protection & Disaster Relief (PPDR) at the ITU, driving the adoption of ITU-R Resolution 646. Mr. Bhatia holds a Engineering degree from the University of Delhi and has studied at the Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration, National University of Singapore and the George Washington University.
