Subject: Twentieth meeting of the Radiocommunication Advisory Group,

Geneva, 22-24 May 2013 and an additional day meeting to consider issues related to the ITU-R Strategic and Operational Plans, Geneva, 21 May 2013

1 Introduction

The twentieth meeting of the Radiocommunication Advisory Group (RAG) will be held at the ITU Geneva headquarters from 22 to 24 May 2013 inclusive. Before the formal opening of the meeting, the RAG will be convening a one-day meeting on 21 May from 0900 to 1700 hours, without interpretation, to consider issues related to the ITU-R Strategic and Operational Plans. As stated in Article 11A of the ITU Convention, the RAG is open to representatives of administrations of Member States and representatives of Sector Members and to the Chairmen of the study groups and other groups. The principal duties of the RAG are, *inter alia*, to review priorities, programmes, operations, financial matters and strategies related to Radiocommunication Assemblies, study groups and the preparation of radiocommunication conferences, and any specific matters as directed by a conference of the Union, a Radiocommunication Assembly or the Council. The RAG recommends measures to foster cooperation and coordination with other standards bodies, with the Telecommunication Standardization Sector, the Telecommunication Development Sector and the General Secretariat.

- 2 The draft agenda of the meeting has been established in consultation with the Chairman of RAG, and is contained in **Annex 1**.

The RAG meeting will commence its deliberations at 1000 hours on 22 May 2013. Registration will begin at 0800 hours on 21 May 2013 in the entrance of the Montbrillant building.
