Broadcasting services

By Administrative Circular CAR/161 dated 5 November 2003, and its Addendum of 9 December 2003, 3 draft new, 3 draft revised and 4 draft modified Recommendations were submitted for simultaneous adoption and approval by correspondence (PSAA), following the procedure of Resolution ITU-R 1-4 (§ 10.3).

The conditions governing this procedure were met on 9 February 2004, with 8 administrations responding in favour of their adoption and approval.
