In accordance with provision 11.4 of WTDC Resolution 1 (Rev, Hyderabad 2010), contributions should be brief and concise, should not exceed five (5) pages and *must* be submitted using the online form available <u>here</u>.

In accordance with Section 12.1 of the same Resolution, contributions should be received at least two months prior to the commencement of the meeting, i.e. **before 7 April 2011**, in order to be translated in the languages of the meeting.

Contributions received less than two months, but at least seven calendar days before the opening of the meeting, i.e. **before 27 May 2011**, will be published as "delayed contributions" in the original language only.

Contributions received less than seven calendar days before the opening of the meeting will not be available for the meeting, but will be held for the next meeting of the Joint Group on Resolution 9.

Contributions for action will not be accepted after the opening of the meeting and documents submitted for information only will be published in the original language received by the Secretariat.
