Subject: **Radiocommunication Study Group 1 (Spectrum management)**

- **Proposed adoption of 2 draft revised ITU-R Recommendations and their simultaneous approval by correspondence in accordance with § A2.6.2.4 of Resolution ITU-R 1-9 (Procedure for the simultaneous adoption and approval by correspondence)**

At the meeting of Radiocommunication Study Group 1, held on 11 June 2026, the Study Group decided to seek adoption of 2 draft revised ITU-R Recommendations by correspondence (§ A2.6.2 of Resolution [ITU-R 1-9](#)) and further decided to apply the procedure for simultaneous adoption and approval by correspondence (PSAA, § A2.6.2.4 of Resolution ITU-R 1-9). The titles and summaries of the draft Recommendations are given in the Annex to this letter. Any Member State raising an objection to the adoption of a draft Recommendation is requested to inform the Director and the Chair of the Study Group of the reasons for the objection.

The consideration period shall extend for 2 months ending on 23 August 2026. If within this period no objections are received from Member States, the draft Recommendations shall be considered to be adopted by Study Group 1. Furthermore, since the PSAA procedure has been followed, the draft Recommendations shall also be considered as approved.

After the above-mentioned deadline, the results of the above procedures will be announced in an Administrative Circular and the approved Recommendations will be published as soon as practicable (see <http://www.itu.int/pub/R-REC>).

Any ITU member organization aware of a patent held by itself or others which may fully or partly cover elements of the draft Recommendations mentioned in this letter is requested to disclose such information to the Secretariat as soon as possible. Titles and summaries of the draft ITU-R Recommendations

Draft revision of Recommendation ITU-R SM.1896-1

Doc. 1/72(Rev.1)

Frequency ranges for global or regional harmonization of short-range devices

This revision adds two new frequency bands, 122.25-130 GHz and 134-136 GHz, used by exterior and in-cabin vehicular radars, in the Table in Annex 2 (frequency ranges for regional harmonization of SRDs).

In addition, *considering a)* has been moved to *recognizing a)*, and new *noting c)* has been added.

Draft revision of Recommendation ITU-R SM.1880-2

Doc. 1/76(Rev.1)

Spectrum occupancy measurement and evaluation

Many changes were needed to improve the language and make the terminology used throughout the document consistent. For example, the use of transmission length, integration time, and revisit time. Also, the observation time is defined as the time needed to perform a measurement on one channel including processing time, but the formula for observation time added a separate term called processing time – this was corrected. Errors associated with the figure were found in section 3.6.1 and corrected. Distinctions between channel occupancy and band occupancy were drawn in some new text in section 3.6.3. A new Figure 6 is added in Annex 2 with slight modification to the accompanying text.
