To Administrations of Member States of the ITU

Subject: Adoption of 12 draft new and 1 draft revised Recommendations by Study Group 6 by correspondence and its simultaneous approval in accordance with § 10.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4 (Procedure for the simultaneous adoption and approval by correspondence) and 1 proposed suppression of a Recommendation

At the meeting of Radiocommunication Study Group 6, held on 6 and 7 May 2004, the Study Group decided to seek adoption of 12 draft new and 1 draft revised Recommendation by correspondence (§ 10.2.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4) and further decided to apply the procedure for simultaneous adoption and approval by correspondence (PSAA), in accordance with § 10.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4. The Study Group also proposed the suppression of 1 Recommendation (see Document 6/90(Rev.1)). Enclosed with this letter are the draft Recommendations in the remaining working languages of the Union, in accordance with your response to Administrative Circular CA/129, Annex 2 (Request for ITU-R circulars and related documents).

In accordance with the provisions of § 10.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4, the consultation period will end on 29 September 2004. If within this period no objections are received from Member States, the draft Recommendations shall be considered to be adopted by Study Group 6. Furthermore, since the PSAA procedure has been followed, the draft Recommendations shall also be considered as approved. However, if any objection is received from a Member State during the consideration period, the procedures given in § 10.2.1.2 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4 shall apply.

After the above-mentioned deadline, the results of the PSAA procedure shall be announced by Administrative Circular (CACE) and the approved Recommendations published as soon as practicable.

Any ITU member organization aware of a patent held by itself or others which may fully or partly cover elements of draft Recommendation(s) proposed for adoption is requested to disclose such information to me, in no case later than the date scheduled for adoption of the Recommendations in this Administrative Circular. The “Statement on Radiocommunication Sector Patent Policy” is contained in Annex 1 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4.
