## Subject:Radiocommunication Study Groups 4 and 9

### Proposed approval of one draft revised Recommendation

At the joint meeting of ITU-R Study Groups 4 (Fixed-satellite service) and 9 (Fixed service) held on 5 September 2006, the Study Groups adopted the text of one draft revised Recommendation and agreed to apply the procedure of Resolution ITU-R 1-4 (see § 10.4.5) for approval of Recommendations by consultation. In accordance with the interim procedures recommended by the RAG at its meeting in November 2004<sup>\*</sup>, the draft Recommendation in English, as revised at the meeting of Study Groups 4 and 9, is enclosed with this letter. The title and summary of the Recommendation are given in Annex 1.

Having regard to the provisions of § 10.4.5.2 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4, you are requested to inform the Secretariat (<u>brsgd@itu.int</u>) by <u>8 February 2007</u>, whether your administration approves or does not approve the draft Recommendation.

A Member State who indicates that a draft Recommendation should not be approved is requested to advise the Secretariat of the reason and to indicate possible changes in order to facilitate further consideration by the study group during the study period (§ 10.4.5.5 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4).

After the above-mentioned deadline, the results of this consultation will be notified in an Administrative Circular and arrangements made for the approved Recommendation to be published in accordance with § 10.4.7 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4.

# Methodologies for interference evaluation from the downlink of the fixed service using high altitude platform stations to the uplink of the fixed-satellite service using the geostationary satellites within the band 27.5-28.35 GHz

This revision adds a new Annex 3 providing another methodology for interference evaluation in terms of *C/I* and its Appendix providing an example of the application of the methodology of the new Annex 3.
