Subject: Rules of Procedure approved by the Radio Regulations Board

Following the 2023 World Radiocommunication Conference, a 2025 edition of the Rules of Procedure was published. The new edition incorporates all revisions up to and including the approved rules of procedure listed in the annex to Circular Letter [CR/520](#) of 1 August 2025.

Pursuant to the provisions of Nos. **13.12** and **13.14** of the Radio Regulations (RR), the Radio Regulations Board (RRB) at its 100th meeting (10 – 14 November 2025) approved changes to the Rules of Procedure, that were also incorporated into the 2025 edition of the Rules of Procedure (see the Annex below).

Those changes comprised modified rules of procedure concerning the Receivability of forms of notice generally applicable to all notified assignments submitted to the Radiocommunication Bureau in application of the Radio Regulatory Procedures, which took effect on 14 November 2025.

In addition, the text of WRC-23 decisions, which had not been included in the Conference's Final Acts but had been reflected in the minutes of WRC-23 Plenary meetings and that had the status of an authentic interpretation of the RR, was included without any modification in the rules of procedure on RR Nos. **4.4**, **5.429D**, **5.429G**, **5.434**, **5.435B**, **21.16**, Appendices **30**, **30A** and **30B**, Resolution **559 (WRC-19)** and the rules concerning the extension of the regulatory time-limit for bringing into use satellite frequency assignments.
