Subject: Radiocommunication Study Group 1

Proposed adoption by correspondence of 1 draft revised Recommendation

At the meeting of Radiocommunication Study Group 1, held on 26 and 27 June 2008, the Study Group decided to seek adoption of 1 draft revised Recommendation according to § 10.2.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-5 (Adoption by a Study Group by correspondence). The title and summary of the Recommendation are given in Annex 1.

The consideration period shall extend for two months ending on 10 September 2008. If no objections are received from Member States during this period, the approval by consultation procedure of § 10.4.5 of Resolution ITU-R 1-5 will be initiated. However, any Member State who objects to the continuation of the approval procedure for the draft Recommendation is requested to advise the Director of the reason and to indicate possible changes to the text in order to resolve the problem.

Automated mobile spectrum monitoring unit

Summary of the revision

The aim of the revision of Recommendation ITU-R SM.1723 is to provide some guidelines on how to define requirements on mobile monitoring unit and to extend the domain of application from automated mobile monitoring unit to mobile monitoring unit.

The *recommends* part of the existing Recommendation deals with the monitoring tasks to be performed by a mobile monitoring unit and its functions. These elements have been moved into a new Annex 1, which provides guidance specific to equipment used in mobile stations and to the requirements of the vehicles themselves.
