**Subject: Radiocommunication Study Group 7**  
– **Proposed adoption by correspondence of 1 draft revised Recommendation**

At the meetings of Radiocommunication Study Group 7, held on 7 and 15 November 2005, the Study Group decided to seek adoption of 1 draft revised Recommendation according to § 10.2.3 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4 (Adoption by a Study Group by correspondence). In accordance with the interim procedures recommended by the RAG at its meeting in November 2004\*, the draft Recommendation in English, as revised at the meeting of Radiocommunication Study Group 7, is enclosed with this letter.

The consideration period shall extend for two months ending on 14 February 2006. If no objections are received from Member States during this period, the approval by consultation procedure of § 10.4.5 of Resolution ITU-R 1-4 will be initiated. However, any Member State who objects to the continuation of the approval procedure for the draft Recommendation is requested to advise the Director of the reason and to indicate possible changes to the text in order to resolve the problem.
