

ASMG Initial Positions to WRC-15 Agenda Items (BB-PPDR and Amateur Issues 1.3, 1.4)

Agenda Item 1.3

- **“to review and revise Resolution 646 (Rev.WRC-12) for broadband public protection and disaster relief (PPDR), in accordance with Resolution 648 (WRC-12)”**
- **ITU-R Responsible Group:** WP 5A
- **ASMG Position:**
 - Support the applications of broadband PPDR.
 - Add the method of (NOC) to Resolution 646 (Rev.WRC-12) to the draft text of CPM.
 - Follow up the results of the WP 5A meeting about the methods of satisfying the agenda item and study them, take a unified position by the final of ASMG meeting before the WRC-15.
 - Oppose the proposal of identification of the band 806-824 / 851-869 MHz for the PPDR Applications.



Agenda Item 1.4

- “to consider possible new allocation to the amateur service on a secondary basis within the band 5 250-5 450 kHz in accordance with Resolution 649 (WRC-12)”
- **ITU-R Responsible Group:** WP 5A
- **ASMG Position:**
 - Not to support any additional allocation of the amateur service in the range (5250 - 5450) kHz due to the heavy usage of important existing services in this band.
 - Follow-up studies in the current WP on this issue, and take a final position at the last meeting of the ASMG group before the WRC.
