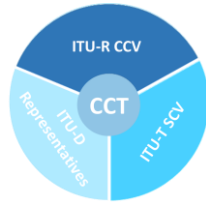

# Activities of the Coordination Committee for Terminology (CCT) (1)



## Structure

- ITU-R Coordination Committee for Vocabulary (**CCV**) functioning in accordance with Resolution ITU-R 36;
- ITU-T Standardization Committee for Vocabulary (**SCV**) functioning in accordance with WTS Resolution 67 (Rev. New Delhi, 2024); and
- representatives of **ITU-D**.



## Texts guiding the work of the CCT

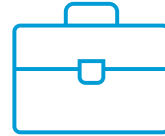
- Council Resolution 1386 (C17, amended C25) was revised to include the responsibilities of the rapporteurs for vocabulary.
- Resolution 154 (Rev. Bucharest, 2022) of the PP on *the use of the six official languages of the Union on an equal footing*.

## Activities of the Coordination Committee for Terminology (CCT) (2)



### Meetings

- In 2025, the CCT met **seven times**.
- Upcoming [meetings](#) of the CCT in 2026:
  - 23 April
  - 18 June
  - 27 August
  - 10 December



### Outcomes

- In 2025, the CCT considered **337 terms in English**, of which **260** were validated and sent for translation.
- The validated terms and definitions are included in:
  - The [ITU terms and definitions database](#)
  - [UNTERM](#)
- Updated Recommendation [ITU-R V.431-9](#) “*Nomenclature of the frequency and wavelength bands used in telecommunications*”.
