ITU-R Report to the first session of the Regional Radiocommunication Conference for planning of the digital terrestrial broadcasting service in parts of Regions 1 and 3, in the frequency bands 174-230 MHz and 470-862 MHz (RRC-04)

Dear Sir/Madam,

- 1. In letter DM-1041 of 30 June 2003, your Government was invited to send a delegation to the Regional Radiocommunication Conference for planning of the digital terrestrial broadcasting service in parts of Regions 1 and 3, in the frequency bands 174-230 MHz and 470-862 MHz (RRC-04), which will take place in Geneva, Switzerland, from 10 to 28 May 2004. In the same letter administrations were requested to indicate their requirements for conference preparatory documents.
- 2. Pending the establishment of the list of requirements for conference documents for each Member State and after consultation with the Director of the Radiocommunication Bureau, please find enclosed Document 3 of the Conference containing the ITU-R input to RRC-04, which was prepared in response to Council Resolution 1185 (modified 2003). This course of action is being taken in order to provide your administration with sufficient time to study the ITU-R input to the Conference and to prepare proposals accordingly. The document will also be included in the first series of documents for the RRC-04, which will be dispatched to your administration in accordance with standard practices.
- 3. The Radiocommunication Bureau is preparing guidelines concerning the formulation of Member States' proposals for the work of the Conference related to the subjects referred to in Document 3. These guidelines will be disseminated shortly by the Director of the Radiocommunication Bureau.
