Registration

Registration for the Plenipotentiary Conference opened on 28 May 2018 and is carried out exclusively online at the conference website at: www.itu.int/pp/registration. Please note that in order to register for PP-18, each participant must have an ITU user account

Visas

For complete details of visa requirements, participants are advised to consult the website of the Host Country at <http://www.pp18dubai.ae/visa.php>. In addition, participants who require a UAE visa must upload their documents on to the website.

Please note that visas cannot be obtained through the ITU secretariat. However, if you wish the ITU secretariat to facilitate the transmittal of information to the Host Country, you are invited to complete the visa information part of the online registration form. This information will then be communicated to the authorities from the United Arab Emirates.
