

Early childhood development influences lifelong health




The years between **0-5** are considered crucial for brain development as the brain develops most between these years



These years are forming the foundation to the child's thinking, behavior, emotional wellbeing, regulatory skills

For Children

Very young children have access to smart devices with limited or no parental settings



The age of children being targeted online by sexual predators is sadly getting younger and younger



With Parents



For parents to educate their children about online risks at a young age to instill healthy digital habits



Encourage parents to lead by example and be aware of the increased risks as children get older, when they seek more independence and online privacy



To prepare parents for the next online milestones and consider balancing the benefits and risks by installing privacy features, parental controls and supervising young children online




Inform parents that younger children can be exposed to inappropriate content by other members of the household and family contracts and agreements can be introduced as a preventative tool






