# PRACTICAL INFORMATION FOR THE COUNCIL WORKING GROUPS AND EXPERT GROUPS MEETINGS

# 1. Registration

**Registration** will be **carried out exclusively online** at <a href="https://www.itu.int/en/council/Pages/registration.aspx">https://www.itu.int/en/council/Pages/registration.aspx</a> and will open **on 5 August 2021**. Detailed information on how to register will be published on the website. The cluster of CWGs will be held fully virtually on Zoom.

# 2. Other pre-requested practical arrangements

Participants are reminded that all meetings will be webcast and can be followed via internet.

## **Working languages**

Meetings will be held in English only, except for the Expert Group on ITRs and the CWG-SFP meetings, for which interpretation upon request will be offered. Requests for interpretation should be made upon registration at least four weeks prior to the opening of the meeting.

## 3. Documentation

#### **Agendas and Documentation**

Draft agendas and documentation to be reviewed at CWGs and Expert Groups will be made available in due course on the respective websites.

#### **Contributions**

Contributions to CWGs/EG-ITRs should be submitted as soon as possible to contributions@itu.int.

In accordance with Council Decision 556, all contributions should be submitted <u>no later than **12 calendar days**</u> before the opening of the Expert Group meeting conducted in one language without translation, and <u>no later than **14 calendar** days</u> before the opening of a meeting conducted in all six languages.

Contributions to the IEG-WTPF-21 should be submitted in accordance with **Decision 611 (modified in 2020)** (see https://www.itu.int/md/S20-CL-C-0081/en).

Contributions to the Open consultation of the CWG-Internet should be submitted in accordance with Resolution 1336 (see https://www.itu.int/md/S19-CL-C-0140/en).

#### Implementation of the information/document access policy

As per Council 2016 decision, and confirmed by PP-18, the ITU Information/document access policy entered into force on 1 January 2017. Documents submitted to CWGs/Expert Groups will be made available as per ITU information/document access policy.
