I have the honour to inform you that, following the kind invitation by the Government of the Republic of Azerbaijan and the approval by Council with the concurrence of a majority of the Member States of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) (see [CL-24/49](#)), the forthcoming World Telecommunication Development Conference (WTDC-25) will be convened in Baku, Republic of Azerbaijan, from 17 to 28 November 2025.
