PRACTICAL INFORMATION FOR THE COUNCIL WORKING GROUP, EXPERT GROUP, AND INFORMAL EXPERT GROUP MFFTINGS

1. Registrations for the CWG-EG-IEG cluster in February

Registrations for the above-mentioned meetings will be carried out exclusively online at the following webpage: https://council.itu.int/2024/en/participation/.

How to collect your badge

In order to receive badges, participants will be requested to provide the registration ID number included in their e-confirmation to the badging desk, together with an official identification card or passport.

Badges can be collected at the desk located at ITU Headquarters in Geneva (Montbrillant building) from Friday, 7 February (pm) to Friday, 21 February 2025.

2. Other pre-requested practical arrangements

Visa Assistance

Administrative assistance for **visa requests should be made online** at the time of registration. Visa requests must be submitted at least *four weeks prior to the opening of the meeting*. Please be aware that the ITU is closed during the period between 24 December 2024 and 1 January 2025, and visa support requests cannot be treated during this period.

Remote participation

Remote participation is available for the CWGs, EGs, and the IEG.

Participants are reminded that all meetings will be webcast and can be followed via internet.

Working languages

Meetings will be held in English only, except for the CWG-FHR, EG-ITRs, and CWG-SFP meetings for which interpretation <u>upon request</u> will be offered. Requests for interpretation for these groups must be made upon registration or sent to <u>sg-registration@itu.int</u> by **10 January 2025** the latest.

Accessibility

Requests for accessibility should be made upon registration at least <u>four weeks prior to the opening of the meeting</u>. The ITU secretariat will meet the expressed requirements to the best of its ability, subject to availability of resources.

3. Documentation

Agendas and Documentation

Draft agendas and documentation to be reviewed at CWGs, EGs, and the IEG will be made available in due course on the respective websites. Meetings will be conducted in a paperless manner. Wireless LAN facilities will be available for use by participants in the meeting rooms.

Contributions

Contributions to CWGs, EGs, and the IEG should be submitted as soon as possible to contributions@itu.int.

In accordance with Council Decision 556, all contributions should be submitted <u>no later than **12 calendar** days</u> before the opening of a Council Working Group meeting conducted in one language without translation, and <u>no later than **14 calendar**</u> days before the opening of a meeting conducted in all six languages.

For the IEG-WTPF, according to the <u>revised schedule for preparation of the WTPF-26 Report by the Secretary-General</u>, the deadline for receipt of comments on the Second Draft and for contribution on possible draft Opinions, as well as the deadline for inputs from the open public consultations has been established as **13 January 2025**.

As per the <u>ITU information/document access policy</u>, documents submitted to CWGs/EGs will be publicly accessible, unless otherwise requested by the submitter(s) of the document.
