Artificial intelligence (AI) continues to evolve at breakneck speed. In this rapidly changing landscape, maintaining an up-to-date picture of national approaches and priorities is essential to support effective cooperation and informed global dialogue. Therefore, pursuant to ITU Plenipotentiary [Resolution 214](#) (Bucharest, 2022) and the World Telecommunication Standardization Assembly [Resolution 101](#) (New Delhi, 2024), and as a follow-up of the [AI Landscape Survey](#) 2023, ITU is seeking to gather information about the current AI landscape of its Member States, including policy approaches, infrastructure capabilities, and capacity-building needs.
