Mr Jianjun CHENG has extensive experience in the field of radiocommunications, especially in spectrum management and international coordination. He is familiar with the Radio Regulations and Rules of Procedure of the International Telecommunication Union. He has participated in several Plenipotentiary Conferences (PP), World Radiocommunication Conferences (WRC), Radiocommunication Assemblies and ITU-R Study Group meetings.

Since 1998, he has taken an important role in China's delegations to WRC-2000, WRC-07, WRC-12, WRC-15 and PP-14, responsible for preparations for conferences, coordination of satellite and space service matters as well as development of China's contributions. In addition, he has been deeply involved in the discussions of rules, procedures and technologies at ITU-R Study Group meetings such as SG4 and SG7. He has drafted a number of contributions submitted to the Radio Regulations Board on the review of the Rules of Procedure. Since 2023, he has been serving as the member of the Radio Regulation Board, actively participating in discussions on interference coordination, regulation implementation, and the formulation and revision of regulations.
