Inmarsat: Restructuring and change of legal status\*

The Administration of the United Kingdom announces, on behalf of *Inmarsat Ltd.*, London, that on 15 April 1999, Inmarsat, the global mobile satellite communications provider, became the first intergovernmental organization to transition to a private company.

The new company, which will be located in London, will be governed by initially a 14-member fiduciary Board of Directors: the Chief Executive Officer and 13 non-executive directors, three of which will represent developing countries.

The new structure comprises two entities: a two-tier private company (Inmarsat Holdings and Inmarsat Ltd.), that will seek an initial public offering (IPO) within approximately two years of formation; and an intergovernmental body, called the *International Mobile Satellite Organization* (*IMSO*), to oversee Inmarsat's delivery of its public service obligations, including the Global Maritime Distress and Safety System (GMDSS).

Inmarsat Ltd., has been recognized by the Administration of the United Kingdom as a recognized operating agency (ROA), in accordance with Article 6 of the ITU Constitution and Nos. 1007 and 1008 of the Annex to the ITU Constitution as incorporated in the Final Acts of the Additional Plenipotentiary Conference (Geneva, 1992).

Established in 1979 to serve the maritime community, Inmarsat has since evolved to become the only provider of a broad range of global mobile satellite communications for distress and safety communications, as well as communications for commercial applications at sea, in the air, and on land.

The Secretary-General of the ITU received on 25 June 1999 from the *Federal Minister of Telecommunications of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia* a letter requesting that the following communication be circulated to the responsible bodies of all countries to which this applies:

(Original text: English - exact quotation from the letter referred to above)

"The Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, as from 23 June 1999 restores its rights and obligations as stipulated by the Convention of the International Telecommunication Union and the Radio Regulations.

As from 24 March 1999 the Ministry of Telecommunications of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia received no regular correspondence of the International Telecommunication Union such as Weekly Circulars, Operational Bulletins, Circular Letters etc. Therefore, all requests, pursuant to the Radio Regulations or to all Regional or Bilateral Agreements, published in the Weekly Circulars of the Bureau of Radiocommunication of the International Telecommunication Union, or in the Special Sections annexed to it, or addressed directly to the Ministry of Telecommunications of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia originated, but not ended before 24 March 1999, or those being originated after 24 March 1999 shall be met, with an inevitable prolongation of the time scale of 85 days. During this period of time the Federal Ministry of Telecommunications of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia had no means to persevere the regular two-way communication with the International Telecommunication Union or the countries devising the coordination requests. All requests, originated after 23 June 1999 shall be dealt with promptly.

This statement overrules the statement of this Ministry, issued on 01 April 1999 by its letter No. 4/1-03-074/99-001."<sup>1)</sup>

# Note by the Radiocommunication Bureau (BR)

By its communication of 13 July 1999, the Federal Ministry of Telecommunications of the FR of Yugoslavia, Novi Beograd, announces the following:

"On the occasion of the 75th anniversary of the Amateur Radio Union of Yugoslavia, the Federal Ministry of Telecommunications of the FR of Yugoslavia authorizes certain Yugoslav amateur stations to use the special prefixes YU75 and YZ75 from 1st August 1999 to 31 December 1999."
