Brazil (country code +55)

Communication of 20.VI.2001*:

Empresa Brasileira de Telecomunicações S.A. (EMBRATEL), Rio de Janeiro, recalls that the Brazilian numbering plan is being updated. The subscriber number format is increasing from seven to eight digits. Changes are scheduled to take place over several months. The general rule for the present changes is described in the table below, and future updates will be communicated as they are introduced.

As from 30 June 2001, in the region of Rio de Janeiro (area code 21), the digit 2 must be added in front of the first digit of the current seven-digit telephone numbers beginning by 2, 4, 5, 6 and 7. There will however be two exceptions to this general rule with regard to number series 460XXXX and 461XXXX. Instead of adding the digit 2, the digit 3 must be added. Example: 460XXXX will change to 3460XXXX and 461XXXX will change to 3461XXXX.

For all other number series, the digit 2 or 3 should be added in front of the old seven-digit telephone numbers beginning with 2, 4, 5, 6 and 7.

The *Post and Telegraph Department*, Bangkok, announces that a new national numbering plan will be introduced for the telephone network of Thailand on 5 July 2001.

The new numbering plan will consist of integrating the existing area code at the beginning of the subscriber number, thus making the national (significant) number (N(S)N):

area code + subscriber number (SN) = eight digits.

Therefore, the national dialling plan for calls in the same area code will be changed from six- or seven-digit subscriber numbers to "0" + eight-digit subscriber numbers. However, the international public telecommunication number, CC (+66) + N(S)N (eight-digit number), will be unchanged.
