The *Ministry of Transport and Communications*, Yerevan, announces that the National Numbering Plan (NNP) of Armenia will be changed on 1 May 2005, 0000 hours (local time).

The changes will affect National Destination Codes (NDC). More specifically, according to the new National Numbering Plan (NNP), the National (Significant) Number (N(S)N) format of the current seven (7) digit numbering plan will change to eight (8) digits.

1. General features of the new plan:

Digit "0" will be added after digit "1" of the existing NDC for Yerevan.

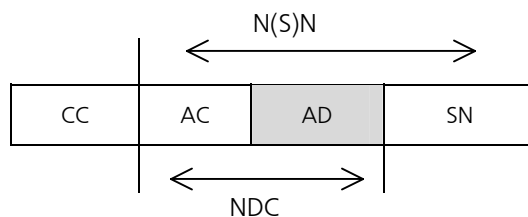
