Both new eight- (8) digit and old seven- (7) digit numbers will run in parallel for a period of three months, with effect from 1 July 2009 to 30 September 2009.

From 1 October 2009 to 30 December 2009, an announcement will be provided to assist subscribers/customers.

The rest of the numbering plan shall remain the same.
