TITLE : KDD STATEMENT ON PATENT RIGHTS REGARDING THE CCITT  
64 kbit/s WIDE-BAND 7 kHz AUDIO CODING

KDD will grant non-exclusive royalty-free licenses under its Patents to any user solely for its use in complying with the Recommendation, but on condition that such user first express willingness to grant to KDD, for itself and its subsidiaries, royalty-free licenses of similar scope under such user's Patents, if any, for use in complying with the Recommendation. Such licenses shall include the right to require third parties to manufacture for use by KDD or the user any equipment the design of which complies with the Recommendation.

At the request of any user, KDD will consider alternative licensing arrangements on reasonable terms and conditions.

As used herein,

"Patents" means patents for inventions made prior to the adoption of the Recommendation which patents are owned or controlled by the grantor (KDD or user) or its subsidiaries; provided, however, that in no event will any licenses granted pursuant to this statement include licenses under any patent, the use of which is not essential to meeting the Recommendation or which can be avoided by those skilled in the art through the exercise of their best efforts.

"Recommendation" means a recommendation by the CCITT for a preferred algorithm for processing 7 kHz bandwidth signals to be transmitted employing the 64 kbit/s subband ADPCM coding as specified in CCITT Rec. G.72X.
