The purpose of this letter is to inform the ITU of AMD's intent regarding its intellectual property that is relevant to the Recommendations being considered by the ITU.

AMD is not prepared to waive its patent rights in the event that the proposed Recommendations (G.dmt, G.lite, G.ploam, G.test, and G.hs) are decided by the ITU-T. AMD is, however, willing to negotiate licenses with other parties on a non-discriminatory basis on reasonable terms and conditions (in accordance with paragraph 2.2 of the ITU-T patent policy) with respect to any patent claims held or controlled by AMD that are essential for compliance on a technological basis with the Recommendations, provided that such parties agree to similarly license their own patents to AMD.
