Title: Support equal funding model for all Member States (MS)

Abstract

Support for implementation of equal funding for all MS that will promote equal opportunity and participation for fair and transparent adoption of standards

1. Problem

The existing in-equal funding based on GDP where the richer nations pay more than developing nations has created the disparity in the contributions and the adoption of standards.

2. Considerations
