Уважаемая госпожа, уважаемый господин,

В мире происходят изменения услуг и систем здравоохранения, отражающие потребность в повышении качества, безопасности и экономической эффективности медицинского ухода. Электронное здравоохранение уже продемонстрировало свою ценность и внесло вклад в осуществление этих перемен. По мере того как страны внедряют электронное здравоохранение, им понадобится интеграция унаследованных разрозненных систем медицинских приборов и информационных систем. В то же время им необходимо будет обеспечить фундамент, на основе которого заинтересованные стороны смогут внедрять инновации, поскольку потенциал электронного здравоохранения в обеспечении постоянного, индивидуального и комплексного ухода может быть реализован только на базе открытых, глобальных, общих и обеспечивающих взаимодействие стандартов.

Многое уже сделано для разработки стандартов и платформ для функционального взаимодействия в области электронного здравоохранения, но в полной мере они еще не реализованы. Продвижение вперед, понимание того, что еще предстоит сделать и какова роль всех заинтересованных сторон, будет способствовать более эффективному использованию ресурсов и работе по конкретным направлениям для ликвидации пробелов. Наряду с этим четкая основа политики и стратегии в области электронного здравоохранения необходима для ориентации развития благоприятной и устойчивой среды.

С этой целью МСЭ совместно с ВОЗ приглашает организации, занимающиеся стандартами здравоохранения, и другие заинтересованные стороны на семинар-практикум в Женеве 26—27 апреля 2012 года, чтобы оценить то, что уже сделано, обсудить, что препятствует внедрению, и внести вклад в разработанную МСЭ-ВОЗ "дорожную карту" для руководства дальнейшими действиями.

Дискуссии в ходе мероприятия будут вестись на основе справочных документов и презентаций.

Мероприятие пройдет в штаб-квартире МСЭ в Женеве 26—27 апреля 2012 года и откроется в 09 час. 30 мин. Information on the Joint ITU-WHO Workshop on "e-Health Standards and Interoperability"

Objectives

The key workshop objective is to start a dialogue towards a comprehensive roadmap on global standards development, interoperability, and adoption for enabling the sustainable development of e-health services.

The resulting programs could leverage resources from regions, countries, industry, and research institutions, and provide a solid platform for harnessing future innovations within specific national e-health roadmaps.

The specific objectives of the Workshop are:

- 1. Learn about different priorities of member states low-, middle- and high-income countries; and identify common threads amongst identified priorities / needs.
- 2. Share experience gained from programs and pilots needs, outcomes, barriers and next steps. This could be used to define specific use cases for which standards should be adopted, and to identify key elements of an e-health service architecture/framework specification.
- 3. Identify barriers to broad adoption of successful initiatives: A diagnosis and deep understanding of why standards are not used/applied in certain settings.
- 4. Assess transformative opportunities: Share advances in innovation that can transform delivery of healthcare (3-7 years). These include advances in mobile devices, portable medical devices, reengineered healthcare workflows, clinical decision support systems, new business models, and novel distribution / logistics strategies in the supply-chain.
- 5. To identify future needs, roles and responsibilities of stakeholders in advancing e-health standards.

Venue

The event will take place in ITU headquarters, Geneva, 26-27 April 2012 and it will open at 0930 hours. Detailed information concerning the meeting room will be displayed on screens at the entrances to ITU headquarters. Registration will open at 0830 hours at the Montbrillant entrance of the ITU building (http://g.co/maps/gqapr).

Language

Discussions will be held in English only.

Participation

Participation is open to ITU members and WHO Member States and to any individual from an ITU or WHO Member State who wishes to contribute to the work. This includes individuals who are also members of international, regional and national organizations. No registration fees required for participation.

Fellowships

ITU will provide a limited number of full fellowships to one participant per eligible country and within the available budget. The participant must be duly authorized by the respective ITU Administrations from Least Developed Countries and from developing countries with per-capita income under US\$ 2,000. While the provision of fellowship is limited to only one participant per country, the number of delegates from a country is not limited provided the expenses of additional delegates are borne by the country. Participants requiring a fellowship are requested to complete the Fellowship Request Form in Annex 4 and return it to the ITU by e-mail: bdtfellowships@itu.int or by fax to: +41 22 730 5778 by 26 March 2012 at the latest.

Visa

We would remind you that citizens of some countries are required to obtain a visa in order to enter and spend any time in Switzerland. The visa must be requested at least four (4) weeks before the date of beginning of the workshop and obtained from the office (embassy or consulate) representing Switzerland in your country or, if there is no such office in your country, from the one that is closest to the country of departure.

Institutions, and at the official request made by them to TSB, the Union can approach the competent Swiss authorities in order to facilitate delivery of the visa but only within the period mentioned of four weeks. Any such request should be made by official letter from the administration or entity you represent. This letter must specify the name and functions, date of birth, number, dates of issue and expiry of passport of the individual(s) for whom the visa(s) is/are requested and be accompanied by a copy of the notification of confirmation of registration approved for the ITU-T workshop in question, and must be sent to TSB by fax (+41 22 730 5853) or e-mail (tsbreg@itu.int), bearing the words "visa request". Please also note that ITU can assist only representatives of ITU Member States, ITU Sector Members, ITU Associates and ITU Academic Institutions.
