Telecommunication Information Exchange Service (TIES)

- Set of networked information resources and services offered without any charge to ITU membership
- To support their participation in ITU activities
- TIES account benefits
 - Personal TIES E-mail
 - Online collaboration tools
 - Access to ITU meeting documents and sites reserved to ITU membership only

- Online application
- Requires authorization from the TIES
 Focal Point

Informal FTP Areas (IFA)

Used by the participants as a repository and an exchange facility for documents and other files.

- Common folders structure
 - docs mirror of documents from DMS, Read access only, will be archived
 - exchange working area where SG participants can upload documents/files, Read+Write access, will be archived
 - temp temporary exchange area

Informal FTP Areas (IFA)

Access to a Study Group's IFA

- Restricted to those with a TIES account, e.g., Member States, Sector Members, Associates, Academia
- How to access a Study Group's IFA
 - Via the WEB using a Web browser http://ifa.itu.int/t/2009/sg#/
 - Via FTP using a FTP client Remote Host: *ifa.itu.int* Subdirectory: /t/2009/sg#

Mailing Lists

Subscription to ITU-T Mailing Lists

- Restricted to ITU-T membership
- TIES account required
- Subscription to the mailing lists
 - Log in to the ITU-T Electronic
 Registration and Subscription Service

 - Choose from the available mailing lists and subscribe

Mailing Lists

Mailing lists default setup

- TIES e-mail default e-mail address for sending and receiving e-mails
- ITU-T Mailing list e-mail if provided, this e-mail becomes the default e-mail address, replacing the TIES e-mail
- Contact e-mail for administrative operations (e.g. contact in case of problems, lost passwords, etc.)

Mailing Lists

Modify your mailing lists profile

- Log in to: <u>http://itu.int/TIES</u>
- Click on "Edit my account"
- Enter your preferred mailing list e-mail address in the ITU-T Mailing List e-mail box
- Send messages from any of the e-mail addresses defined in your profile
- Receive messages on the default e-mail address

Meeting Documents Sync Application

- Download and synchronize documents of a current SG meeting to your local drive
 - Available for all current ITU-T SG meetings
 - Download, save on the Desktop and run following simple on-screen instructions
 TIES account required

Discussion Forums

- Online discussions in the form of posted messages
 - Organized by SG Structure (Working Parties)
 - TIES account required
 - Log in, choose or create a topic and join in the discussions
 - Complement to or an alternative to the mailing lists

- QUICK DEMOS and Q & A
 - Access a study group IFA using a FTP client
 - Subscribe to a study group mailing list
 - Update mailing list profile
 - Download and synchronize documents of a current SG meeting
 - Create a topic and post messages in the Discussion Forum
