1 – Familiarity with ITU-T standards

- Majority familiar with ITU-T standards
- ITU-T Recommendations relevant and useful in developing countries
- Areas of most interest:
 - Series D: Tariffs
 - Series E: Numbering
 - Series G: Transmission
 - Series Q: Switching
 - Series X: Data networks, security



1 – Familiarity with ITU-T standards

Difficulties:

- Demands and equipment different from ITU-T Recommendations
- Financial aspects
- Lack of human resources
- Several suggestions to improve ITU-T's services to developing countries



2 – Updating Resolutions and hosting workshops

- Familiarity with Resolutions quite high
- interest in the proposals of modifications to be discussed in WTSA-08
- interest in regional workshops on a wide variety of topics
- Interest for hosting such workshops



3 - Study Group participation

- Participation mainly in ITU-D SG2 and ITU-T SG3
- Support necessary for Developing Countries to organize and participate in ITU standardization meetings
