- The International Telecommunication Union (ITU) together with TechAmerica Europe is organizing the second Green Standards Week from 17 to 21 September 2012 in Paris, France, which will be hosted by Microsoft.
- 2 The Green Standards Week will be structured as follows:
- High Level Segment on Greening the Economy through ICT Standards to be held on 17 September 2012 and jointly organized by ITU, TechAmerica Europe and Microsoft.
- Award Ceremony of the ITU Green ICT Application Challenge to be held on 17 September 2012 and jointly organized by ITU and Telefónica.
- Forum on Greener Smarter Better Cities to be held on 18 September 2012 and organized by ITU and the European Commission (EC).
- Forum on Boosting Smart Grids through Energy Efficient ICT to be held on 18 September 2012 and organized by ITU.
- Technology Focused Sessions to be held on 18-19 September 2012.
- Forum on *Environmental Sustainability for the ICT Sector*, to be held on 19 September 2012 and jointly organized by ITU and European Telecommunications Network Operators' Association (ETNO).
- Forum on *Greening ICT Supply Chain* to be held on 19 September 2012 and jointly organized by ITU,
 United Nations University (UNU) and Center for Environment and Development for the Arab Region
 and Europe (CEDARE).

- Forum on Mapping E-Waste to Address Future Challenges to be held on 20 September 2012 and jointly organized by ITU, UNU and CEDARE.
- Information and Training Session on ITU Methodologies for Environmental Impact Assessment of ICT
 to be held on 20 September 2012 and jointly organized by ITU and Global e-Sustainability Initiative
 (GeSI).
- Closed meeting of the ITU/WMO/UNESCO-IOC Joint Task Force to be held on 20 September 2012.
- Second Workshop on Using Submarine Communications Networks for Climate Monitoring and Tsunami Warning to be held on 21 September 2012 and jointly organized by ITU, World Meteorological Organization (WMO) and Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO-IOC).
- The main purpose is to move forward the climate agenda and raise awareness of the importance and opportunities of using ICTs to tackle environmental challenges.
- The Green Standards Week will bring together leading specialists in the field, from top policy-makers to standards experts, engineers, designers, planners, government officials, regulators, and others.
- 5 Participation in the event is open to ITU Member States, Sector Members, Associates and Academia and to any individual or company from a Member State of ITU who wishes to contribute to the work.
- Participation in the ITU Green Standards Week is free of charge but no fellowships will be granted. Discussions will be held in English only.
