#### **RECOMMENDATION 784**

# EXCHANGE OF TELEVISION PROGRAMMES ON 16 mm FILM WITH TWO SYNCHRONOUS SOUND TRACKS ON A SEPARATE SUPPORT

(Question 41/11)

(1992)

The CCIR,

recommends

that when television programmes are exchanged having two high-quality sound tracks, when the vision support is 16 mm film, the following specifications should apply:

#### 1. Sound support

When the vision component of the programme is on 16 mm film, the two sound components should be on a separate 16 mm magnetic film.

## 2. Sound recording specifications

The dimensions and position of the tracks and the recording characteristics for the magnetic film should conform to Fig. 2 of CCIR Recommendation 265.

## 3. Picture film specifications

The picture film should conform to CCIR Recommendation 265.

### 4. Allocation of tracks

The allocation of tracks on the separate 16 mm magnetic film should be as follows:

– for stereo sound:

centre track: left channel,

edge track: right channel;

for independent synchronous sounds:

centre track: dubbing or subtitling sound;

edge track: original transmission sound.
