Internet Governance

- ⊙ WSIS Working Group on Internet Governance, 2003, Geneva: *Internet governance is the development and application by Governments, the private sector and civil society, in their respective roles, of shared principles, norms, rules, decision-making procedures, and programmes that shape the evolution and use of the Internet*
- ⊙ WSIS and WSIS outcomes (IGF, enhanced cooperation)
- ⊙ NETmundial Initiative
- ⊙ From the governance of Internet Critical Resources to the regulation of content, privacy, cybersecurity and responsibility of online platforms
