#### 4. VISA FORMALITIES

If you are traveling to the USA from overseas to attend this conference, you will need a B-1 (business) visa. Once the online registration is released, all participants will be asked to identify if they will need a visa to attend. ## 8. CURRENCY

The official currency of the United States of America is the United States dollar (USD).

1 USD = 0.97 CHF

1 USD = 0.88 Euro

1 USD = 0.79 GBP

It is recommended that currency exchange be done at the airport. There is one bank that provides currency exchange on campus: Wells Fargo. It is located at 645 State St. NW Atlanta, GA 30313.

All widely used and globally approved bank cards are accepted nearly everywhere, including Visa, American Express, and MasterCard. Bank hours in the United States are Monday - Friday, 09:00am to 17:00pm.

## 9. ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES

The voltage in the United States is 120 volts. All hotels and conference venues will have outlets with 120 volts. Attendees should plan to bring their own converters, if needed.

## 10. LANGUAGES

The conference will be held in English only.

## 11. SECURITY

Overall, the conference is located in a safe area with well-lit streets and appropriate security presence.

In the event of an emergency, conference attendees should dial 9-1-1 to reach an emergency operator.
