About the Host

Cyber Security Brunei (CSB) is the national cyber security agency of Brunei Darussalam, operating under the purview of the Ministry of Transport and Infocommunications and is currently led by an Interim Commissioner. CSB monitors and coordinates national efforts in addressing cyber security



threats, formulating and implementing strategies, policies and framework governing cybersecurity, with relevant critical information infrastructures (CIIs) as its main constituents. Its core services consist of Brunei Computer Emergency Response Team (BruCERT), National Digital Forensic Laboratory (NDFL) and Cyber Watch Centre.

About Brunei Darussalam

Brunei is an Islamic sultanate on the northern shore of the island of Borneo with a land mass of only 5,765 sq. km, surrounded by Malaysia and the South China Sea. It gained independence from the British in 1984, and is a member of the Commonwealth and ASEAN (Association of Southeast Asian Nations). Nearly three-quarters of the country is covered in pristine rainforest, and the economy is centered around the oil and gas industry. Its population of about 450,000 is predominantly made up of Malays, with significant Chinese and indigenous populations.

Weather

Brunei Darussalam has an equatorial climate all year round, characterised by temperatures ranging from 24° to 35° Celsius, with high humidity and higher than average rainfall. The climate in Brunei is generally hot and wet throughout the year. However, it can get chilly indoors due to air conditioning.

Language

The official language in Brunei is Malay (Bahasa Melayu), however English is widely spoken and understood. Chinese dialects and native languages are also spoken by segments of the population.

Religion

Islam is the official religion, and about 66% of the population are Muslim. Other faiths practiced include Christianity and Buddhism.

Dress code

The dress code for this event on Day 1 will be business professional, while Day 2 and 3 are business casual.

Tourists should observe a modest/conservative dress code while in Brunei. If you decide to visit a mosque, women are required to cover their head, shoulders and knees. Some mosques will provide a simple robe and shawl to meet this standard.

Local Transportation

- Taxis in Brunei are available outside the airport's arrival hall. A ride from the airport to one of the recommended hotels will cost around B\$20 from 6am to 9pm, or B\$25 from 9pm to 6am.
 Tip: Get your taxi driver's phone number so you can call to arrange for transportation in the future. Your hotel can also help to arrange for a taxi.

- Please note Grab and Uber do not operate in Brunei.

Currency

- Brunei dollar (BND) is equivalent to Singapore dollar (SGD) and both currencies can be used in Brunei.
- Money exchange is available at the airport arrival hall and at licensed money changers. The current exchange rate is around USD\$1 equals BND\$1.35.
- Credit cards are widely accepted at most major establishments. However, some shops and restaurants will only accept cash and will not have a credit card facility.
- ATMs can be found in most shopping centres.

Telecommunications

The IDD code in Brunei is +673.

There are 3 telecommunication companies in Brunei and all have booths at the airport arrival hall where you will be able to purchase SIM cards.

Electricity

The standard voltage in Brunei is 240 volts and uses British Standard three-pin plug (G type plug/socket).

Business Hours

Government offices are open from 7.45am to 12.15pm and from 1.30 to 4.30pm and are closed on Fridays and Sundays. Private offices usually operate from 8am to 5pm on weekdays. Banks are generally open from 9am to 4pm on Mondays to Fridays and 9am to 11am on Saturdays. Most shopping malls are open daily from 10am to 10pm. All offices and business premises are closed on Fridays between 12 noon to 2pm for Friday prayers.

Smoking

Smoking is prohibited in all enclosed public places and workplaces. It is also banned in specific places including sidewalks near business premises, public staircases, public areas, government buildings, hospitals, recreational areas, airport building, educational centers, restaurants and on public transport.

Alcohol

Alcoholic beverages cannot be legally purchased in Brunei. Non-Muslims aged 17 and over are permitted to import a limited amount of alcohol for personal consumption in private.
