1. General information

Dates: From Tuesday 01 July to Friday 04 July 2025

For participants from countries without a Republic of Congo diplomatic mission, entry visa facilitation will be provided upon presentation of the official invitation letter. Special airport visa waivers will also be arranged in such cases to ensure smooth entry.
