



THE 4 PILLARS OF EUTELSAT HUMANITARIAN STRATEGY

CRISIS CONNECTIVITY CHARTER

- **I** Eutelsat coordinated the crisis connectivity charter representing the satellite industry in negotiations with the UN for the first 2.5yrs.
- The charter has committed 9 satellite fleet operators to donate equipment and bandwidth covering the globe, ready to supply communications to the UN first responders
- The charter is the first such agreement between an industrial sector and the UN. The satellite industry is therefore ahead of logistics, Big pharma, ICT, etc. in its commitment to disaster relief.

NGO DISASTER RESPONSE - NETHOPE

- Eutelsat donated 20 satellite terminals with free bandwidth to help with the Ebola outbreak in Sierra Leone in 2015. These terminals were used to supply communications to 20 remote hospitals and clinics.
- Eutelsat donated 15 satellite terminals with free bandwidth to help with the refugee crisis on 2016 helping to connect over 300,000 refugees.




