Eui K. Koh Ph.D. President Asia-Pacific Satellite Communications Council

Professional Biography

Eui K. Koh is serving his second term as the president of the Asia-Pacific Satellite Communications Council (APSCC), a non-profit international association representing all sectors of satellite/space related industries. During his first term (2003-2004), Dr. Koh helped make the organization an indispensable asset to the industry. His initial success resulted a unanimous vote for his re-election at the APSCC Plenary meeting on September 4, 2004.

Dr. Koh has more than 30 years experience in the telecommunications industry. Currently, he is the President of ASA Technologies, a satellite/space and telecommunications consulting firm based in Singapore. In the past, he served as the Vice President for the Asia-Pacific region at New Skies Satellites N.V., a global satellite service provider. Prior to joining New Skies Satellites, he was Managing Director, Asia-Pacific, at Intelsat, one of the largest global satellite operators with shareholders from more than 140 countries. He was responsible for business development and marketing activities in the region. He held several senior technical positions in the Engineering Division and played a significant role in the design of future Intelsat satellite systems in the Systems Engineering and Planning Department.

Prior to joining Intelsat, he worked with the American Satellite Corporation and Hughes Network Systems in Germantown, Maryland, where he participated in the digital satellite system design. He also served as an Advisor to the Electronics Telecommunications Research Institute (ETRI) of Korea, where he helped to pioneer the early system design of KoreaSat.

Dr. Koh received his Bachelor's of Science Degree in Electrical Engineering from Hanyang University in Seoul, Korea and earned his Master of Science degree and Ph.D in Electrical Engineering at the Catholic University of America in Washington D.C.

Dr. Koh is a Senior Member of the IEEE and had an active role in various international and regional telecommunications organizations such as Asia-Pacific Telecommunity (APT) and the Pacific Telecommunications Council (PTC) for which he served on the Board of Governors in 2003. He has also contributed numerous articles to publications in the satellite communications field.
