

**Terms and Conditions for Participation in the Generation Connect Global E-waste Iconathon**

1. The Generation Connect Global E-waste Iconathon (“E-waste Iconathon”) is organized by the International Telecommunication Union (“ITU” or the “Organizer”). By submitting your registration form for participation in the E-waste Iconathon, you accept the present terms and conditions.
2. You hereby warrant that all information submitted is true, complete, and up-to-date. You further represent and warrant that you are at least 18 years and maximum 29 years of age at the time of submitting your registration form for participation in the E-waste Iconathon.
3. You represent that neither you nor any members of your family (up to the third degree) are employed by the Organizer, or [the Secretariats of the Basel, Rotterdam and Stockholm conventions](#), [StEP Initiative](#), and the [WEEE Forum](#), (collectively, the “Partners”). The Organizer reserves the right to verify your eligibility for participation in the E-waste Iconathon as well as the accuracy of your submitted information.
4. By participating in the E-waste Iconathon, you acknowledge and agree that the winning icon will be placed in the public domain. Accordingly, in the event that you are selected as the winner of the E-waste Iconathon, you hereby irrevocably waive, or, if such waiver is not permitted by applicable law, agree not to assert, any moral rights in and to the winning icon, including any and all rights of identification of authorship and any and all rights of approval, restriction or limitation on use or subsequent modifications.
5. The Organizer reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify you if it reasonably considers that the information you have provided and/or your submission do not comply with the terms, instructions and guidelines provided in the [E-waste Iconathon Guidelines](#), the [E-waste Iconathon registration form](#), as well as the present terms and conditions.
6. The selection of the three finalists of the E-waste Iconathon will be made in the first week of April by a judging committee and communicated via email to the three finalists and on the [event website](#). The winner will be selected by vote by the Youth summit attendees and announced during the E-waste Iconathon event at the Youth Summit.
7. The three finalists of the E-waste Iconathon will be offered the possibility to attend the ITU Generation Connect Youth Summit (“Youth Summit”) on 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> of June 2022. In this context, the Organizer will provide the three finalists with (i) a round trip economy flight ticket to/from the location, (ii) health and accident insurance coverage for the duration of the Youth Summit and (iii) accommodation and per diem subsistence allowance for the duration of the Youth Summit.
8. Notwithstanding the previous section, the selected three finalists shall be responsible for defraying all other costs and expenses arising from or relating to their participation in the Youth Summit, including any travel or accommodation costs not covered by the reward mentioned in the previous section. Moreover, the finalists are solely responsible for meeting all necessary visa requirements and having all necessary travel documentation in order prior to travel.

9. No substitution or transfer of the above-mentioned reward by the three finalists is permitted.
10. You permit the Organizer and Partners to use your name, likeness, video and/or photograph in connection with the E-waste Iconathon, in any media, worldwide, at no remuneration.
11. You understand and agree that the Organizer and Partners may create content based on your participation in the E-waste Iconathon and your submission, such as blog posts, photos or social media postings which may be published on the Organizer's and/or the Partners' websites and other communication channels and made available to the public, at the Organizer's or Partners' discretion.
12. You are not allowed to use the Organizer and/or Partners name, emblem or the logos of any Organizer and Partners events without the prior written permission of the Organizer or the Partners.
13. All submissions must not: a. violate the intellectual property rights of third parties; b. be illegal under applicable national laws and international law; c. depict or incite hatred, defame, abuse, harass, stalk, threaten a specific person or social group, incite violence or conflict or otherwise violate the legal rights of third parties (including those of privacy and publicity) and d. violate the terms of use of any social media service, website, mobile application or any other platform used in connection with your submission. You agree to release and hold harmless the Organizer from and against any and all claims, expenses, and liability arising out of or relating to your participation in the E-waste Iconathon and the content of your submission.
14. You acknowledge and agree that your participation in the E-waste Iconathon is free of charge but does not entail any right to compensation of any kind or to reimbursement of any expenses incurred from such participation.
15. The Organizer is not responsible for any lost, late, corrupted, mutilated or misdirected submissions, or submissions not received within the established deadlines.
16. You acknowledge and agree that the Organizer is entitled to modify the content of the [E-waste Iconathon website](#) and related documents and/or the present terms and conditions and to abbreviate, modify, suspend, cancel or terminate the E-waste Iconathon (in whole, or in part) without any obligation, by notifying you via an announcement at the [E-waste Iconathon website](#).
17. The Organizer reserves the right to make all final decisions regarding the E-waste Iconathon. Nothing herein shall be considered to be a limitation or a waiver of the privileges and immunities of the Organizer, which are specifically reserved.
