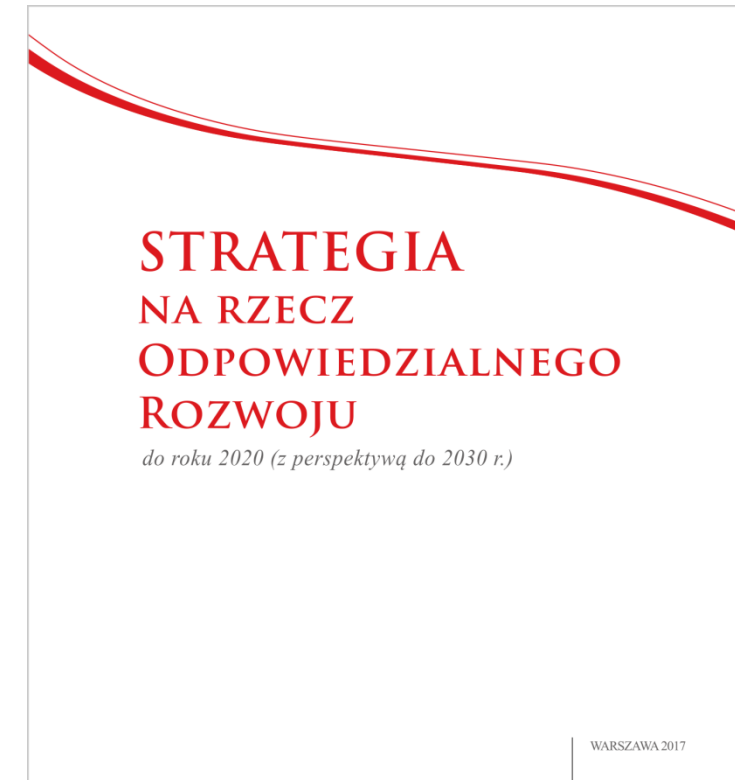

# Strategy for Responsible Development

Five pillars:

- Reindustrialization
- Development of innovative companies
- Increased savings
- Foreign expansion
- Sustainable social and regional development



# Start in Poland

- Government program for startups
- Budget: PLN 3 bn
- 1 500 innovative companies to be established in the next 7 years
- First project: Scale-up acceleration program



# The Act on Innovation

- „Small Innovation Act”  
January 2017
- To foster innovation
- Changes in taxation of IPR  
and patents
- Increased limits of R&D costs  
that can be deducted from tax
- „Big Innovation Act”  
under consultation
- To limit barriers in innovative  
activity
- Based on Whitepaper on  
Innovation which identified  
barriers

## Support of innovative solutions

- Cooperation with business incubators, R&D departments
- Monitoring ICT industry to adjust regulatory environment
- Participation in government projects
- Promoting existing innovation
