

David Souter is Managing Director of ict Development Associates, which he founded in 2002, and which provides expertise at the interface between the Information Society and public policy, particularly concerning development, environment, governance and rights. He has worked for many years with UN agencies including ITU, UNESCO, UNCTAD, CSTD and DESA, as well as with the World Bank and other international organisations.
