GENERAL COUNTRY INFORMATION BULLETIN

1. SITE OF THE TRAINING

The meeting will be held at the Kofi Annan International Peace Keeping Centre (KAIPTC), Teshie, Accra.

2. VISA

- While all travelers arriving in Ghana should have a valid passport, entry visas are not required for nationals from Economic Community of the West African States (ECOWAS) states and some other countries.
- Participants are therefore advised to ascertain whether or not they are exempted from visa requirements at their respective Ghana Embassies.
- Participants from other countries who have Embassies of Ghana in their countries should apply for visas
 well in advance to be issued upon presentation of documentation.
- Visa on arrival fee is US\$150.00.

3. HEALTH

Participants must ensure they take along travel insurance (including health) from their home country for
the duration of their stay in Ghana. Presentation of a yellow fever vaccination certificate at the point of
entry is required of all Participants.

6 TRANSPORT

- Kotoka International Airports is situated 10km (20 minutes' drive) from the city centre, Taxi Fares from the airport to the city centre are between GH¢40.00 and GH¢50.00
- Transportation between other hotels and the meetings venue could be provided at their request. Practical
 arrangements for such transportation will be finalized after participant's arrival and registration.

8 LOCAL CURRENCY AND FOREIGN EXCHANGE

• The basic unit of currency is the cedi; there are coins of 1 pesewa, 5 pesewas, 10 pesewas, 20 pesewas, 50 pesewas and one cedi. Notes are issued in the denomination of GH¢1.00, GH¢2.00, GH¢5.00, GH¢10.00, GH¢20.00 and GH¢50.00. (GH¢ -Ghana Cedi). The major Foreign Exchange Rates are as follows:

Local voltage is 220/240V, 50 Hz with British type 2 pin/3pin sockets.
