 - Situated utopian and dystopian scenarios





Methods


- Current and prospective network operators

- Co-design workshop: to understand challenges and prototype solutions in both mature and nascent
- Deployment Workshop: Exploring possible improvements to suitability of RadiusDesk/MeshDesk:

Findings

- Challenges with existing NM interfaces e.g icons, terminologies, and finding devices
- Access to an eco-system of experts, formal and informal training, Infrastructure sustainability & power cuts interfering with the controllers
- Adhoc equipments, troubleshooting resources not suited to level of expertise available








Content Creation and Dissemination
