The International Telecommunication Union (ITU) and the Government of the Republic of Mauritius are pleased to invite your organization to the ITU annual regional human capacity building workshop for Sub-Saharan African countries to be held at the Holiday Inn Mauritius in Mon Trésor, Plaine Magnien, Mauritius, from 28 - 30 June 2017.

The workshop is organized by ITU Regional Office for Africa in partnership with the National Computer Board of Mauritius who are hosting the event.

This year's theme is "*Developing the ICT ecosystem to harness Internet-of-Things*" and aims to provide an opportunity for the participants to express their views and experiences on the following:

- How to make practical use of IoTs and associated technologies such as Big data, analytics and other such platforms using hands-on exercises.

The main objective of these annual workshops is to provide a platform to African countries to share experiences, strengthen their knowledge and raise awareness on matters concerning the selected theme through a multi-stakeholders approach involving the role of government, educators, ICT/telecoms regulators and ministries, industry civil society, NGO and other organizations.
