At the kind invitation of the Ministry for Information, Broadcasting, Telecommunications and Information Technology of Antigua and Barbuda, the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) is pleased to invite your organization to participate in the Regional Youth CT Innovations Training Workshop to be held 8<sup>th</sup> -10<sup>th</sup> December 2014, in St. John, Antigua and Barbuda. The workshop is organized by Telecommunication Development Bureau of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) in collaboration with, and supported by the Caribbean National Telecommunications Organization (CANTO).

The workshop is specifically aimed at youths who want to pursue a career in the ICT industry, those who have businesses in the ICT industry or those who want to gain ICT related skills. The Objectives of the Youth Workshop are, inter alia

- To provide the youths with an opportunity to understand and discuss new technologies and applications and the implications of ICT use and adoption with an emphasis on Innovative technologies for connecting rural areas
- examine the role that markets play in the development and distribution of ICT infrastructure and services

The programme takes the guide of the BYND2015 Global Youth Summit held September 2013 in Costa Rica.
