#### B. Formalities of entry to Panama

3. VISA

All foreign visitors who enter the Republic of Panama, must have a valid passport (with at least three months before its expiry date) and return ticket to their country of origin or residence.

Citizens from countries that require a visa should apply for a visa to the nearest Panama Embassy or Consulate at least four weeks in advance of the departure.

The requirements for obtaining visa in these cases are:

- Passport valid for 90 days
- Passport photocopy with the general information and passport photo
- Complete visa application form
- Note from your company, certifying your participation in activity to be held in Panama. (You may need an invitation letter from the Autoridad Nacional de los Servicios Públicos to present to the corresponding nearest Panama Embassy or Consulate, therefore please find the invitation letter ANNEX 1)

#### Transportation services

## 4. AIRPORT:

Tocumen International Airport has been recognized as one of the more important airports in the region. Panama's privileged geographic position, as a meeting spot between the two Americas and for the entire world, has maintained it permanently as a key element in the area of air transportation, where it has distinguished itself with regard to experience and security. It is located on Domingo Diaz Avenue, just 30 minutes from Panama City.

## 5. TAXI AT THE AIRPORT:

There is a taxi stand in the area outside the airport once you go through Customs. The 30-minute ride from Tocumen Airport to Panama City can cost around \$20.00 The official rate is \$10.00 per person if you share the taxi with four passengers, \$14.00 per person if sharing with two passengers and \$25.00 for a private taxi.

- 6. TAXI IN THE CITY OF PANAMA: Local taxis are yellow and the rates are based on a zone system. It is recommended to ask/check the rate before you take the cab.
- 7. METRO DE PANAMÁ: Panama Metro System: It is a modern system of mass transportation consisting in a network of urban trains passing through their own road on Rails and without occupying existing road space, moving passengers efficiently and safely to the nearest station to their final destination. The first underground line starts at the Albrook bus Terminal (as opposed to Albrook Mall) and ends in the Andes shopping center. It covers an area of 13.52 kilometers and has 13 stations. The trip is carried out in 23 minutes. To use this service, you must purchase the Metro Card priced at US\$2.00, which can be purchased at the Metro stations. The cost per trip in the subway is 35 cents. It operates on a regular

schedule from 5:00 am to 10:00 pm from Monday to Saturday and from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 pm on Sundays.

The climate is tropical in Panama. The temperatures are relatively high but vary during the year. In the West (Pacific Ocean side) of the country, the temperatures are usually lower than in the East (Atlantic side).

Temperatures in Panama City range between 26 ° and 34 ° C and 70-85% relative humidity during the event

The official currency of the Republic of Panama is the Balboa. However circulating paper currency is the American dollar. The US dollar circulates freely being the rate of change 1 Balboa = 1 Dollar.

12. MIRAFLORES VISITOR CENTER: Located on the east side of the Miraflores Locks, the Miraflores Visitor Center is the ide al place to observe the Canal operations. From large balconies, visitors can watch as the lock gates are opened and closed for ships to start or complete their journey through the Canal. Center Hours: From Monday to Sunday, holidays included. Ticket Office: 9:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Exhibition halls,



snack bars and gift shop: 9:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Restaurant: 12:00 p.m. - 11:30 p.m.

- 13. CASCO ANTIGUO OLD TOWN: Panama's historic quarter. It is the oldest neighborhood of Panama City, where the ancient and the modern coexist in harmony making your visit a memorable and pleasant experience. It was declared a world heritage site by UNESCO. It's not just history, is a place to taste different types of meals and drinks in outdoor cafes. In addition to enjoy music and varied entertainment offered by restaurants and bars, you will also find several souvenir places with a variety of typical crafts of Panama.
- 14. LA CINTA COSTERA COASTAL STRIP: The Coastal Strip of Panama City is a place to enjoy the green areas without leaving the metropolis. The strip covers 35 hectares, 16 of which are completely devoted to green spaces. Bordering the Bay of Panama, the strip links modern Punta Paitilla to the Old Town district. As you walk along, the road takes you from skyscrapers on one end to colonial-





era constructions on the other.

- **15. MALLS:** In Panama City we can mention four commercial and a large, eye-catching attraction for tourism Malls: Multicentro, Multiplaza, Albrook Mall and Metromall.
  - Multicentro: Located on Balboa Avenue, Paitilla. It has 100 stores, a world-class casino, 9 cinemas last generation, entertainment centers for children, a Food Court for 1,000 people, two restaurants and 3,000 free parking under roof.

#### **INVITATION LETTER REQUEST FORM**

All foreign visitors entering to Panama must have a valid passport. Visitors from countries **whose citizens require a visa should at the earliest time and well in advance of travel apply for a visa at a Panama Embassy or Consulate.** You may need a letter of invitation from Panama host, which you will need to present to the Panama Embassy/Consulate in your area in order to obtain your visa. The visa must be requested at least four (4) weeks before the date of beginning of the meeting and obtained from the office (embassy or consulate) representing Panama in your country or, if there is no such office in your country, from the one that is closest to the country of departure.
