I am pleased to invite you to participate in the IV Regional Forum on Inter-connectivity & Reduction of telecommunication service prices and Internet access cost to be held on 11 and 12 August 2016 in Tegucigalpa, Honduras. This Forum is organized at the kind invitation of the National Commission of Telecommunications (CONATEL). The Forum will be held back-to-back with the Meeting of the Standardization Committee of COMTELCA to be held on 8 to 10 August 2016.

During the sessions will discuss, among other things, international interconnection, study cases of national IXP's implementation in the Region, its benefits, future projects, the role of the regulator, the necessity of international and/or regional interconnection, etc.

Considering that during the event will be presented proposed models on international interconnection, it is recommended that participants be at decision-making level to have discussions on the topic.

There will be no fees to participate in the event, however travel arrangements, accommodation and daily expenses should be made and borne by the participating entity. Fellowships will be granted to eligible participants from Least Developed and Low Income Countries of the Americas Region.

Concerned participants are strongly advised to apply for their entry visa to Honduras as early as possible as the approval procedure may take several days and the Honduras Embassy/Consulate may request an invitation letter from the CONATEL.
