**TITLE: Regulatory Improvement Policy**

The Communications Regulation Commission - CRC of Colombia developed a project aimed to define and document the Regulatory Improvement Policy of the Entity, understanding "Regulatory Improvement" as a comprehensive concept that includes some of the fundamental pillars previously identified by the CRC for the development of its regulatory work, including: regulatory agenda, simplification, application of the Regulatory Impact Analysis (AIN - Spanish initials) methodology, knowledge of the ecosystem and alternative and innovative regulatory mechanisms. In that sense, in august 2022 the CRC published the regulatory improvement policy document and an annex document with study cases that explains how the Commission has applied AIN methodology, including different methodologies for the evaluation of alternatives regarding design and development of regulation in telecommunications and postal sectors.
